KYBURZ Switzerland AG announces succession plan – SIC Group AG acquires the company

KYBURZ Switzerland AG is positioning itself for its next phase of development. As part of a long-planned succession process, Swiss investment company SIC Group AG has acquired the company from founder Martin Kyburz and the existing minority shareholders. The transaction will not affect the company's operations, strategic direction, customer and supplier relationships, brand, or production site in Embrach. The existing management team will continue to lead the business and execute KYBURZ's international growth strategy.

Since its foundation 35 years ago, KYBURZ Switzerland AG has grown from a small development workshop into a leading international manufacturer of electric commercial vehicles. Over the past 20 years, KYBURZ has significantly shaped and revolutionised last-mile postal delivery with its vehicles and services.

Today, KYBURZ's distinctive vehicles are a familiar sight on the roads in numerous European countries as well as in Australia. Its largest customers include national postal organisations in Switzerland, Australia and Scandinavia, which operate some of the world's largest electric delivery fleets. Building on this strong market position, KYBURZ has continuously expanded its technological capabilities and sustainability initiatives.

A pioneer in sustainable electric commercial vehicles

KYBURZ Switzerland AG currently employs over 160 staff at its headquarters in Embrach and develops, manufactures and markets its vehicles and services internationally. In addition to its successful DXP, DXC, DX2 and PLUS vehicle platforms, the company has produced numerous innovations in the fields of fleet management, digitalisation and battery technology in recent years, thereby establishing itself as an innovative provider of sustainable mobility solutions.

The fleet management division gave rise to the independent company Traconiq, which today develops and markets telematics and fleet management solutions for commercial vehicle fleets. Another milestone was the research and development of a revolutionary process for the direct recycling of lithium-ion batteries. With these developments, KYBURZ has established itself as a pioneer in sustainable mobility and the circular economy.

With its new facility in Embrach, opened in 2025, KYBURZ now operates a state-of-the-art centre for the development, production, sales and servicing of electric vehicles. The site forms the basis for the company's future development.

Following the change of ownership, the company's values, strategic direction, the Embrach site, the KYBURZ brand and all customer and supplier relationships remain unchanged.

Experienced management team to continue leading growth

The current management team, comprising CEO Dr Stefan Breu, COO Flurin Vicentini and CSO Michael Heegewald, will continue to pursue the current growth strategy.

The change of ownership will not result in any changes for customers, suppliers or business partners. All contracts, projects and business relationships will continue as before.
